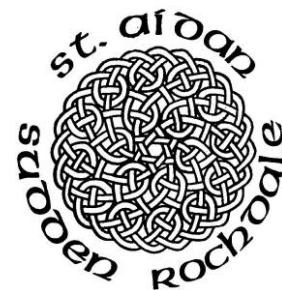

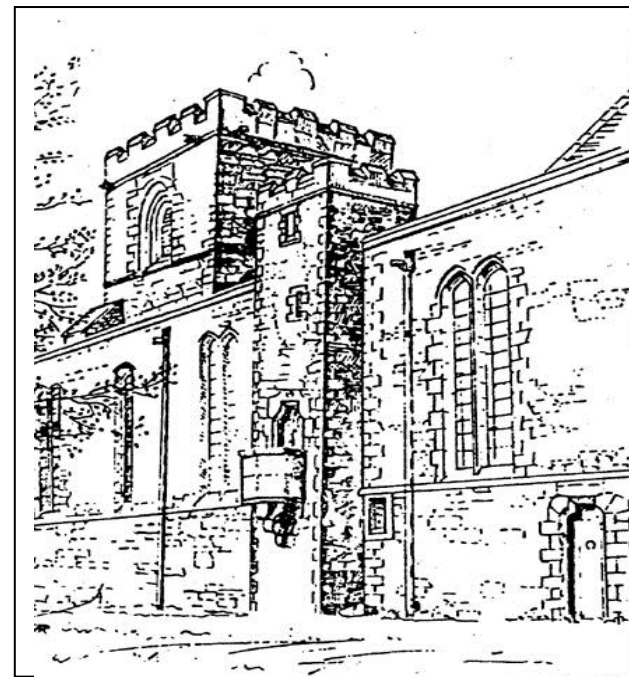

FOOD BANK NEWS

Since the Foodbank opened at the beginning of Nov up to end of March, Foodbank has responded to 1166 individuals with vouchers asking for food donations to help them through a difficult time, just over 16 tonnes of food have been given out, almost all of this food has been donated by individuals, most through local churches. Since the start of the yr the amount given out each mth has exceeded the amount donated. They expect that even more people will need their help once the government's new benefits system begins to take effect, while they have some stock in reserve, it is mostly soup, vegetables & beans, They therefore urgently need continuing donations of other items from the list at the back of Church by the Foodbank container.
