ROCHDALE FOODBANK NEWS

April has been our busiest month yet: 297 Clients were provided with three-day food supplies making a total helped since we opened in November last year of 1900 adults and 900 children. That demand for our help will continue to grow is virtually certain as the changes in welfare payments begin to take effect. The trend we reported last month continues with more food being given out than we are receiving in donations meaning we sometimes have to use our limited funds to bolster essential supplies. In April we gave out 4 tonnes but 3.3 tonnes were donated. So, please continue to support us with food from the 'shopping list' (rochdale.foodbank.org.uk) or with financial support to enable us to continue this vital work.
