FOODBANK NEWS FOR JUNE

Demand for our help continues to grow. In May we redeemed 311 vouchers for supplies of emergency food making a total of 1700 vouchers serving 3200 individuals since we opened on 1 November last year. Thanks to you, our dedicated supporters, and much to our relief we received 4.4 tonnes of donated food in May and distributed 4.00 tonnes thus building up our reserve stocks slightly. However, from time to time we do have to purchase additional supplies to cover specific shortages so financial support is important too. Looking ahead, during June and July both Tesco and Asda are generously hosting further collection days for us which will help to maintain our stocks over the summer.At a training meeting which preceded our A.G.M. on 3 June we had very positive and helpful presentations by two of our voucher issuing agencies, Citizens Advice and the newly formed Rochdale Council Community Champions department which gave both sides valuable insights into how the other operated and we hope to extend this further to other partner organisations in the future.
