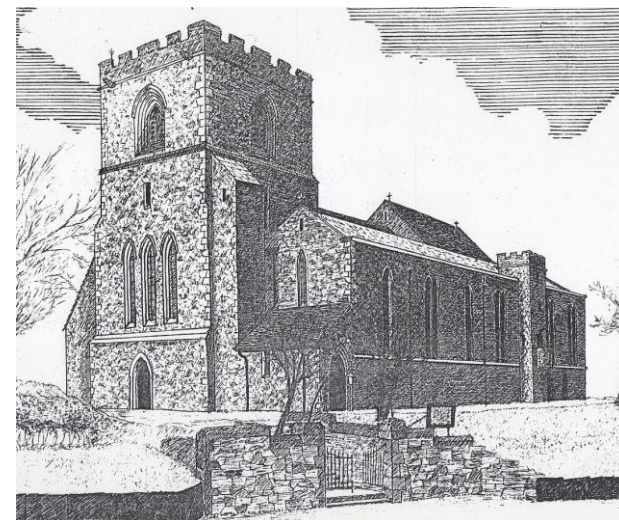

ST AIDAN'S PARISH 100 YRS AGO

Revd Hartley Harrison reported on the plans for a Town Hall Bazaar to raise money for the new Church and the first opening of the Church Builders' Boxes which yielded 3049 pennies, £12 14s 1d. Meanwhile a crowded motor coach excursion took place on 12th July 1913 to Wycoller Dene. Parishioners were also informed that the contract for the building of St Aidan's Church had been awarded to Messrs Ullathorne of Selby, The restorers of Selby Abbey after the fire.

First sincere thanks to all of you who have been supporting us whether with donations of food or money. Please keep it up because we need 1tonne each week just to keep up with demand. In June we gave out 3.9 tonnes in response to 316 vouchers issued but received just 3.5 tonnes in donated food reducing our reserve stock to 4.8 tonnes. Our lowest level yet. This meant that we had to spend £600 to cover specific shortages. Since Nov we have fed over 4000 individuals of whom 1350 were children. We rely on your help & support to continue this work
