

FOODBANK NEWS

The anniversary of the first yr came at the end of what was our busiest month since opening with 396 food vouchers honoured. During the year we have received 55 tonnes and given out 47 tonnes of food. Also during October we were delighted to receive 8.6 tonnes from local Churches and Schools from their Harvest Festivals and, although this has given us a welcome temporary boost, we still rely on the committed weekly support from you, our regular supporters.

At present we have more than enough stocks of baked beans, soups, tinned and packet pasta and, thanks to generous corporate support from Kelloggs, cereals too. Most frequently we seem to run out of staples such as milk and sugar, puddings spreads and instant mash and have to dip in to our limited funds in buying these.

During the last weekend of this month and the first in December look out for our volunteers when we are invited to collect food in Tesco and Asda; always a good response and an opportunity to tell more people about our work.

IMPORTANT

In the past many of you will have signed a declaration to say you are a UK taxpayer and for every pound you give to St Aidans, the PCC can claim 25p back from HMRC. However that 25p can only be claimed back if it has been paid by you in the first instance ie you have paid tax on any income or capital gains. If over recent yrs your tax status has changed and you no longer pay tax you MUST inform Joanne Elcock. Joanne is The Gift Aid Secretary and submits a claim to HMRC on behalf of The PCC.
