ROCHDALE FOODBANK NEWS

. After our 2013 Christmas 'peak' the numbers seeking our help have settled back to an average of 400 a month but this is still a major concern and a struggle to deal with. The total weight in food given out was 4.4 metric tonnes but we were only able to achieve this by spending £1200 from financial donations to buy in some of the staple foods needed for our packages

We currently have plenty of cans of soup and baked beans, pasta and cereals so please refer to our 'Shopping List' (http://rochdale.foodbank.org.uk/) for other suggestions. Also this month we have been giving fresh potato, carrot and onion with stock cubes and tomatoes (tinned or puree) for clients to make their own soup. This is proving very popular. The fresh veg is donated each week by the **Rotary Club**.

On 15 and 22 March Tesco and Asda are hosting collections for us in store which our volunteers will be manning. If you're shopping on either of these days do please look out for us. These are always valuable occasions not just for receiving donated goods but also to meet and thank supporters and potential supporters face to face.
