### ROCHDALE FOODBANK NEWS

We're now settling in to our new premises at 8 South Parade where an army of volunteers successfully managed the move on 4/5 April. The new premises (next door to the previous site) are slightly smaller but lighter and the main area is all on one level making serving our Clients that bit easier.

During April we had only 303 Clients and so only gave out 3.5 tonnes of food but, though the drop in the number of clients is welcome, only 2.5 tonnes were donated in that month meaning that we had to spend over £500 to give our clients a good balanced food box. The cost of this 'topping-up' on a regular basis when added to the higher rent and running expenses will begin to put a strain on our finances in the coming months so your continuing support in prayer and practical giving, whether of food or money, is very much appreciated by us and by the people we seek to help.
