St. Aídan's Church Sudden, Rochdale

100th Anniversary of the Consecration of St. Aidan's Church.

Dr. Knox, the Bishop of Manchester consecrated St. Aidan's Church on **Wednesday 24th March, 1915**.

The parishioners and their first Vicar, the Rev. Hartley Harrison, must have been very proud of their achievements. The Church had been designed by Temple Moore, a distinguished church architect and built by T S Ullathorne & Sons of Selby. The original design for the Church had been modified and there were insufficient funds to complete the Tower. This all took place in the middle of the Great War when many of the young men of the Parish were fighting for their country or had already been listed as casualties.

This morning we are offering thanks for the life and work of St. Aidan's Church for over 100 years.

We have inherited not only a beautiful building but also the pride and determination of that original congregation. We are proud of St Aidan's Church not just as a building but also as an important part of the local community.

Bishop Knox concluded his sermon

"I pray that God will give you grace to use aright the gift which He has put into your possession."

The original congregation struggled at a difficult time to erect a church for the people of Sudden. May we gratefully accept our responsibility for continuing the work which they began for the next century and beyond.
