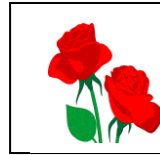
## Dedications to a Loved One

The Flowers In The Manchester Road Porch are in Loving Memory of The June Birthdays of Elaine Fowler's Parents



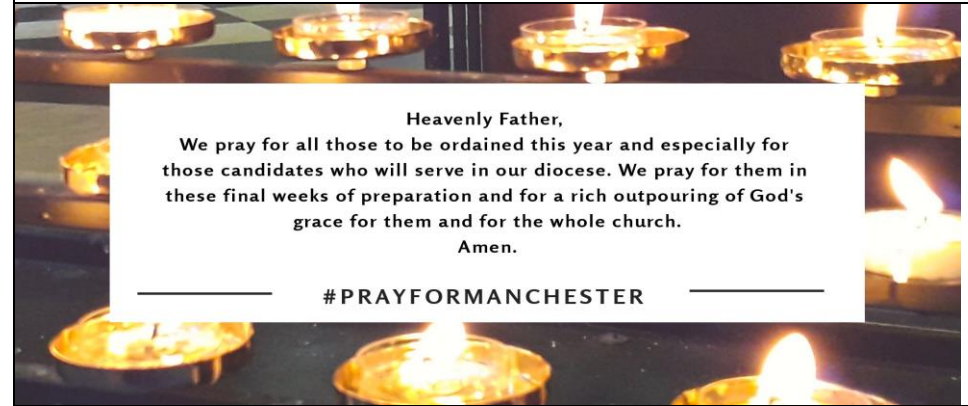
## Robinson Room
