Did you know that

St Alban's Church in Rochdale was a mother church of St Aidan's Church, our church having been formed from the Parishes of St Martin, All Souls and St Alban.

Revd Hartley Harrison (1865-1930), was the Curate of St Alban's Church from 1897 before becoming our first Vicar.

The church archives include some copies of the *St Alban's Church Parish Magazine* which include "Sudden Notes" written by Revd Harrison detailing the efforts to set up St Aidan's prior to the laying of the Foundation Stone in 1913 – 105 years ago this October.

St Alban's Church was demolished in 1972. If you would like to have a look at the church archives, please ask Revd Michael or Ann Montgomery.
